


Accessing the Learning Control Center (Back Door)

To access the Learning Control Center from the home page navigate to the gear icon, select control center, then learning.




Import Your SCORM/AICC Content

Select Scorm/AICC... from the drop down menu.




Select a SCORM or AICC Compliant **Zip** File to Import

Select appropriate file and desired course catalog, then click OK.




Upon Success

When content successfully uploads into Halogen the following image will display:

Once uploaded, the file will default to the name of the authoring tool you used to create the content. For example, if you used Adobe Captivate the title will appear as, "Adobe Captivate E-Learning Course" and if you used Adobe Presenter the title will appear as, "Adobe_Presenter". If the course title is not immediately displayed utilize the "type" and "catalog" search feature to locate your draft.




Upon Failure


When content fails to upload into Halogen the following image will display:



- 1. Ensure that the project is SCORM Compliant.
 - a. If you are publishing in Adobe Captivate the process is as follows:
 - i. File>Project Info>Quiz>Reporting> then check the Quiz box at the top of the screen to, "enable reporting for this project".




- b. If you are publishing in Adobe Presenter the process is as follows:
 - i. Manage>Reporting then select SCORM and click OK.




2. Next, ensure that the file is zipped during publishing. Select HTML5 as the Branch no longer supports SWF (Flash) files.



When File Uploads but is Unplayable or Images and Animations are Distorted

If you published the file in HTML use the HTML Tracker to determine if any features in your course are preventing the project from playing.

- 1. In Captivate select Project> "HTML Tracker".
 - a. Remove any unsupported objects or animations.



2. In Adobe Presenter open the Animation Pane by navigating to "Animations" in the top ribbon.
